Applications are invited for a Summer School jointly organized by University of Khartoum and Ibn Sina Specialised Hospital (Sudan), University of Goettingen and University Medical Centre (Germany) and Makerere University, Uganda with the theme:

“Molecular evolution of *Mycobacterium avium* subsp. *paratuberculosis* in Africa”

The summer school aims at arousing interest in research on *Mycobacterium avium* subsp. *paratuberculosis*, the cause of Johne's disease in animals and a possible implicated pathogen in Crohn's disease in humans.

The school will run from: February 9 – 19, 2020 Venue: Makerere University, Kampala – Uganda

- **Who can apply?** Young researchers, PhD students/candidates from African countries are encouraged to apply.
Equal chances for males and females and for countries will be considered.

Applications should include the following:

- Motivation letter, Short CV including publications (if any) and the title of the master thesis
- An abstract for a seminar describing the disease situation in his/her country (half page)
- Recommendation letter from the supervisor or the head of the department/Institute
